MLS NEXT SAFETY & WELLBEING POLICY

<u>Bullying</u> includes repeated and/or severe physical, verbal, social, sexual, or criminal behaviors that are:

- 1. aggressive;
- 2. directed at another;
- 3. and intended or likely to hurt, control, or diminish the other person emotionally, physically, or sexually.

Hazing is any conduct that subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, humiliate, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of joining or being socially accepted by a group, club team, or other organization.

Report hazing and bullying to the Club and, as appropriate, MLS **NEXT and the US Center for SafeSport.**

PARENTAL SUPPORT HOW TO HELP

- Talk openly and frequently with your children about bullying and hazing.
